

Who Saw the Most Growth in 2010?

SAKE VOLUME from Japan to the US grew 15% to 3,465 kiloliters and dollar value gained 19% to \$33,618,000, according to the USDA. This does not include the roughly 1.5 million cases of domestically made sake. Henry Sidel, president of Joto Sake, told WSD that they were up 30% in 2010 to almost 9,000 cases.
